



HOW TO MAKE FLUFFY SLIME

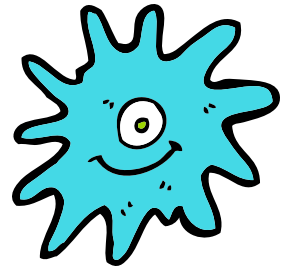
Have you been wondering How to make Fluffy Slime and the difference in a regular slime recipe?

Fluffy slime is less sticky, less messy, and its so much harder to mess up for those slime novices. What makes fluffy slime...well...fluffy?

FLUFFY SLIME INGREDIENTS



Glue: I always use GALLON SIZED GLUE. Tiny bottles do not produce a lot of slime and this is an addicting project. Go ahead and get the gallon size because you will be addicted to making slime!

Liquid Starch - You can find liquid starch in the laundry detergent aisle of major stores like Walmart. You can also order online and I use the Stay-Flo kind.

Food coloring - I use Wilton's Color Right for the best and brightest results. You can buy an entire kit with multiple colors. Food coloring goes a long way and should last you for months or more.

Shaving Cream - Get the cheap dollar store shaving cream that fluffs up and is white

Additional items needed: Glass bowl, spoon and any fun additives like colored balls as seen here

HOW TO MAKE FLUFFY SLIME



- Start with about 2 cups of glue. In the demonstration I used clear glue but quickly realized the shaving cream turned it white, so its really a crap shoot.
- Spray in about a 1 cup worth of cheap shaving cream.
- Stir together and your glue should start to puff up and double in size in your bowl. If you are going to add color, you can add it and adjust at this time.
- Now add liquid starch. Your liquid starch is what makes your slime stick together but if you over add, your slime will be hard. Because of that, you only need 1/3rd cup or less of starch to your bowl
- The slime will form almost immediately when stirred.
- Take your slime out and knead on a piece of nonstick parchment paper, a glass plate or a vinyl. Do not knead on paper as it will stick!
- Slime still too sticky? Dip back in starch, but keep patient because mixing your slime out of stickiness often takes upwards of 5 minutes before it releases from your hands. You can always add just a tad bit of starch to your hands and mix some more and it should start to slide off.
- Fluffy slime is easier than most slimes and typically has less of a sticking to everything issue than regular slime.
